- Level 3 (Advanced): Vehicle-, marine-, wildland (urban interface) & structure fires. Also include failure analysis, incendiary fires, appliances and management of complex investigations and much more

After completion of all three levels of the development program, Dynamic Incident Management will assist with the applications and completion of the International Association of Arson Investigation Technician (IAAI-FIT) exams (exam costs for each person's own account)
